Dear Campers and Parents,

We are inviting your child to spend one week of their summer with us at Camp Winaca HemoVon June 10-14, 2024. Camp will be held at <a href="Camp Twin Creeks">Camp Twin Creeks</a> in Marlinton, WV, about 50 minutes from Snowshoe Resort. Who attends camp? Children ages 7-17 with either a childhood cancer diagnosis or a bleeding disorder are eligible to attend.

The mission of camp is to positively impact and enrich the lives of children diagnosed with cancer or bleeding disorders by offering a camp experience, independent from their family, in a medically safe and educationally supportive environment while promotion personal growth, self-worth, self-reliance and creativity through activities and the development of personal relationships that carry over to their daily lives and throughout their lifetime.

Activities include horseback riding, archery, ziplining, climbing wall, swimming, paddle boarding, kayaking, fishing, creek walks, hiking, biking, crafts, basketball, tennis, gaga, woodworking, and campfires with smores.

Medical staff from WVU Medicine are on site 24 hours during the week of camp. Parents/guardians are able to access camp pictures online during the week of camp.

Transportation is provided for any camper needing transportation. Two charter buses will be available with one route from Charleston/Beckley and the other route from

Morgantown/Clarksburg/Buckhannon/Elkins. Complete the Transportation Form included with online registration. Additional transportation information is provided in the Camper Parent Handbook.

## **Paper Registration Packet**

Please call me at 304-293-1205 to request a packet by mail or ask one of the clinic staff to give you a Registration Packet.

All campers must have a health care provider complete the Health Care Provider Form and campers must have been seen within 12 months of the date of camp. In addition, a copy of your campers immunization record must be included and must be current for tetanus.

### **Camper Registration closes May 25<sup>th</sup>**

We ask that you help us protect the health of our campers and staff this summer. If anyone who is sick or was sick with a communicable disease like COVID-19, RSV, Flu, or recently in contact with someone with COVID-19 or another communicable disease or fever in the 7 days prior or at the start of camp, then we would ask that your child not attend camp. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us keep everyone as safe as possible.
